

THORNTON DALE CRICKET CLUB EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

GUIDELINES FOR DEALING WITH AN INCIDENT/ACCIDENT

- Stay calm but act swiftly and observe the situation. Is there danger of further injuries?
- Listen to what the injured person is saying
- Alert the first aider who should take appropriate action for minor injuries
- First Aid Box in kitchen
- In the event of an injury requiring specialist treatment, call the emergency services
- Do not move someone with major injuries

Dial 999 (or 112)

- Tell the operator which emergency service you require
- To help effectively, the ambulance needs clear information about the injured person
- They also need to know the location of the cricket ground – see directions below
- Check entrance gate to cricket field is unlocked and open

Post Code of Pavilion and Hall Farm is YO18 7SA
Thornton Dale cricket ground is behind/east of Hall Farm
Use entrance road to main village car park off Maltongate
Grid Reference on O.S. map is SE 836 828

IN EVENT OF FIRE

- Clear the building and vacate to the field
- Call emergency services – see above

AT JUNIOR MATCHES/COACHING OR FOR JUNIOR PLAYER IN SENIOR TEAM

- In addition to above, deal with rest of group, ensure they are adequately supervised
- Contact the injured person's parent/carer or guardian – see list of contacts
- Complete an incident/accident report form and pass to Club Welfare Officer
